The Sasfin BCI Prudential Fund is a managed portfolio seeking to deliver long term capital growth and income normally associated with the investment structure of a moderate risk profile retirement fund.

# **Investment Approach**

In order to benefit from positive market conditions and to provide a limited measure of capital and income protection during negative market conditions, the Manager will manage the portfolio's equity, property and fixed interest asset allocation actively to align the portfolio with the Manager's outlook of such conditions. In order to achieve this objective the investments to be acquired for the portfolio will include listed property related securities, equity securities, preference shares, non-equity securities, fixed interest instruments (including, but not limited to, bonds, corporate bonds, inflation linked bonds, convertible bonds, cash deposits and money market instruments) and assets in liquid form. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments. The manager may also include unlisted forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions.



## Moderate - High Risk

- This portfolio holds more equity exposure than a medium risk portfolio but less than a high-risk portfolio. In turn the expected volatility is higher than a medium risk portfolio, but less than a high-risk portfolio. The probability of losses is higher than that of a medium risk portfolio, but less than a high-risk portfolio and the expected potential long term investment returns could therefore be higher than a medium risk portfolio.
