INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

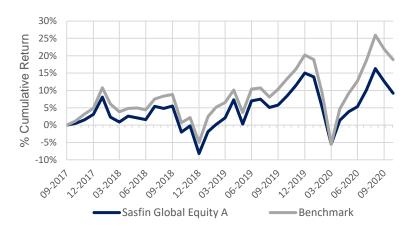
The Fund aims to achieve a superior risk-adjusted total return, over a long-term investment horizon, relative to the Morgan Stanley Capital International (MSCI) All Country World Index (ACWI), in US Dollars.

INVESTMENT UNIVERSE

The Fund will predominantly invest directly in companies listed on major global equity exchanges.

It may also invest in other financial and derivative instruments such as money markets and other Funds to assist with efficient money management, to manage the variability of returns, or to obtain diversification in specialist areas not covered by major equity securities.

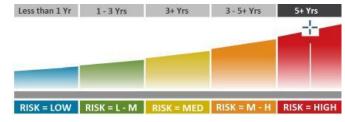

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INVESTMENT MANAGER COMMENT

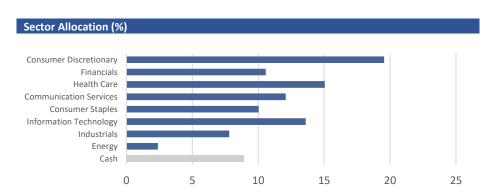
October saw a sell-off in global equity markets with growing fears stemming from a renewal of lockdowns across Europe, talks of additional stimulus being passed by the US congress continuing to fail and the upcoming US election which brings its own set of anxiety and fearmongering.

Despite the sell-off, Big Tech stocks delivered an impressive set of results for the third quarter. During the second quarter Alphabet's (+10%) advertising revenue suffered its first decline in its history but this quarter saw it return to its growth path. Amazon (-4%) continues to benefit from the pull-forward of e-commerce which led to sales growth exceeding 30% in both North America as well as other regions across the globe. In addition, while still a small component of its revenue base, Amazon grew its advertising revenue by more than 50%. Microsoft (-4%) has benefited from the work from home environment as its results showed strong growth in its Surface laptop sales, gaming revenue and Microsoft Teams platform. Cloud computing continues to be a significant driver in revenue for Alphabet, Amazon and Microsoft with all three achieving high double-digit growth as cloud computing continues to become larger part of their operations so much so in Microsoft's case that cloud revenue may soon exceed the revenue generated from its Windows operating system.

Another beneficiary of the work from home environment has been Activision Blizzard (-6%). The video gaming company delivered a strong set of results for the quarter primarily driven by its Call of Duty franchise. The first-person shooter game saw its user base grow significantly compared to the prior year with the mobile version being the top grossing new gaming app in the US store since its release and has already attracted over 50 million subscribers prior to its release in China. Other companies that continue to benefit from conditions under the pandemic include Nestlé (-6%), the world's largest food group, which achieved better than expected revenue growth driven by demand for home convenience foods and pet food. Swiss-based healthcare company Roche (-6%) saw its revenue growth return to positive territory during the quarter despite the impact of biosimilars eroding the base of its pharmaceutical sales. Offsetting the impact of biosimilars were sales of new pharmaceutical products as well as its diagnostics revenue stemming from COVID-19 testing. On the other end of the spectrum, the pandemic weighed on Visa's (-9%) results as a decline in travel led to lower cross-border transaction volumes for the payments processor.
